Adrian Schmid is the Thursday Gold Tour winner



The course for Thursday Gold Tour opening was built with obstacles up to 140 cm. Competition was judged according to the art. 238.2.1. that means against the clock.

Crowd watched the fastest and clear round thanks to Swiss rider Adrian Schmid, who rode chestnut gelding Alcazar Sitte. They achieved time 58,32 sec. that bet about 3 seconds the second competitor.

Home fans could be satisfied because of great results of two Czech representatives. Zuzana Zelinková with mare Evita R finished as second followed by Kamil Papoušek in the saddle of chestnut stallion Quentino Donth-M.

More than 70 combinations participated at the third test of this day and 23 of them finished with clear round. Several riders took just time penalty points.

CSI Olomouc EY Cup brought success for Krzystof Okla

More than 40 riders up to 25 years participated at the very last Thursday competition counted for the European Youngster Cup Tour. U25 riders fought on obstacles up to 135/140 cm.

Polish rider Krzystof Okla with horse Djembe van het Schaarbroek was only rider who came through the second phase finish line in time faster than 30 seconds and took the first position. Italian couple Giorgia Failla and Cliff de Brinco Lindenhof finished on the second place, when she came with time two second slower than the winner.

Austrian Melanie Buchner and Zilton add the elite trinity. The competition was successful also for other riders from Austria, when four of them were placed in TOP10.

Barbora Tomanová was the best home representatives. She completed both phases without faults first time with Corcovado and later also with mare Crocodile Dundee. Moreover their rider with Crocodile Dundee brought her the fifth place.

• CSI Olomouc Youngster Tour determined for six and seven years old horses was opened by competition up to 125/130 cm against the clock. Polish rider Michal Kazmierczak with horse Wilander went for the victory.



• Silver Tour up to 130 cm was opening competition of Thursday and in the same time of the fourth J&T Banka CSI3*W Olomouc 2017. Polish rider Krzystof Ludwiczak and horse Poli Loli L won the class, Czech rider Vladislava Humpliková with Buena Utopia finished at second place.

• Polish eqipe took three of four victories of the first day. They can celebrate thanks to results of Michal Kazmierczak, Krzystof Ludwiczak a Krzystof Okla.

• The best Czech couple of Youngster Tour competition was Alexander Baraldi and Sopranist K. Their time was enough for tenth place. Other Czech riders Rudolf Doležal (Arista) and Zuzana Zelinková (Lint) completed the course with 0 penalties.

• Four Thursday competitions attracted 239 couples. The Gold Tour with 75 combinations (rider plus horse) was the most busy class. 61 riders participated at the Silver Tour and almost 60 competed at the Gold Tour opening.
