Garcia proved his class at Saturday Diamond Tour



One of the Saturday top parts during the CSI in Olomouc was Diamond Tour with obstacles up to 150 cm. Two rounds competition served also as the second qualification for the World Cup Grand Prix of Olomouc city.

All clear couples came to the second round, it mean twentytwo totally. It was pleasant for home fans, that four of them were from Czech republic.

Finally the best placed rider on the Longines ranking of presenting competitors Juan Carlos Garcia from Italy proved his class, when took brilliant won with Gitano V Berkenbroeck.

German Tobias Meyer on Eagle finished on second place and Polish rider Maksymilian Wechta with Celtia II cross the finish line as the third one. The best Czech rider was Aleš Opatrný (Idario VH Netehof) on fourth position.

EY Cup final for Swedish Antonia Andersson

Saturday program brought the European Youngster Cup Final for riders U25, that served for the winner as the direct qualification to the overall serie final held in Salzburg in December.

Swedish rider Antonia Andersson, who competed with IC Magic Van De Bien, won in jump-off and took the earned the ticket in the Austrian final. Denise Ruth (AUT) in the saddle Stand Up 8 overcame the course up to 145 cm as the second one, Willi Fischer (AUT) with Colmar 2 finished on third place.

Five couples from Czech republic went also to the jump-off. Tina Šalková with mare Frascati Van Ter Hulst came as the best Czech rider on fifth place followed by Kateřina de Jagerová and gelding Candy Boy. Barbora Tomanová (Crocodile Dundee) came for eighth rank of results list and Kateřina Málková and Bugatti Van Dwerse Hagen finished on ninth position. Alexandr Baraldi (Spectrum) was eleventh.



Czech riders successful at the CSIYH Final

• CSIYH Tour for six and seven years old horses was closed by the final held on Saturday. Kamil Papoušek (Cartano K) won the jump-off. Marek Hentšel and Pandrola took second place and Marianne Schindele (AUT) with Be Check It Out.

• Saturday morning Silver Tour was built with obstacles up to 135 cm. Matthias Atzmüller (AUT) with Chap B crossed the finish line as winner. Second placed was occupied by Szabolcs Kruscó (HUN) and Chacco Boy, Michal Kazmierczak (POL) was third.

• EY Cup final winner Antonia Andersson earned the direct qualification to the overall final held in Salzburg in December. EY Cup 2017 is the serial determined for riders U25 with seventeen qualifications events in Europe.

• Czech rider Sára Vingrálková with Chieano won the CSIJ for juniors. It was for second time in Olomouc. The same rider with Dollar Look was first allread one day ago. Next postitions were: Virág Weinhardt (HUN) and Petronela Neuschlová (SVK).

• German breed was the most succesfull from the perspective of TOP10 placed horses at the CSIYH final. Six horses of any German stud book were there, also Czech and Slovakian Warmblood were presented thanks to Forewer and Pandrola.
